WXXI CLASSICAL MEMORIES

As we continue down FM 91.5's Memory Lane we find more great moments from our archives.



When WXXI-FM 91.5 signed on the air on December 23, 1974, the schedule was a mixed format of music, news and talk programming. Public broadcasting was in its early years. It had been just seven years since then President Lyndon B. Johnson



signed the Public Broadcasting Act, dedicating a portion of the radio spectrum "to the people." The early years were a time of trying and testing all kinds of programming, both locally and nationally. Many of the programs we know today hadn't even been imagined, but would soon become staples of public radio. "All Things Considered" (1971), "A Prairie Home Companion" (1974), "With Heart and Voice" (1975), "Morning Edition" (1979), all became flagship programs of public radio. In 1977 WXXI began airing complete concerts from the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra. **This photo from 1987** shows the announcement of Jerzy Semkov's appointment as Interim Conductor of the RPO.
